## Admission Rules & Regulations:

4 year Undergraduate Programme  
U.G. (Honours) or U.G. (Honours with Research)  
*with single major and single minor*

&

3 -Year Undergraduate Programme  
*with single major and single minor* ,(morning

### 1.CRITERIA FOR ADMISSION TO U.G PROGRAMME/S

**\*ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION:** All the admissions to the different U.G. Programmes running by the Raiganj University will be on merit and availability of seats. There will be reservation of seats for SC/ST/OBC/EWS/ Differently Able Candidates as per Government Rules. All the admissions will be provisional subject to the registration of the candidate with the University. For differently-abled candidates' minimum disability at least 40% will be considered. The detailed criteria is as under-

- (i) The admission to Under –Graduate Degree Programs will be governed by the guidelines of the University and the Higher Education Department of Govt. of West Bengal as framed from time to time.
- (ii) A Candidate shall be allowed to pursue any one of the Under - Graduate Programs of the University (not more than one) in a particular Academic Session.
- (iii) No applicant shall be allowed for admission aft a lapse of more than 5 years from the year of passing the previous qualifying examination.
- (i) Applicants who have passed the Higher Secondary (10+2) or an equivalent exam are eligible to apply for admission to the first year of the 3 YEAR and 4-YEAR UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAM (B.A./B.SC./B.COM./B.B.A./B.C.A.) provided they have also passed in English with full marks of at least 100.
- (ii) Applicants may apply for admission to the first year of the 3 YEAR and 4-YEAR UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAM if they have passed the Higher Secondary (10+2.) Applicants who have passed Vocational Examination conducted by the West Bengal State Council of Vocational Education and Training in regular mode shall be eligible to take admission to the 3-YEAR UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAM only. No applicant, however, shall be admitted if more than five years have passed since the candidate's prior qualifying examination year.
- (iii) In case of other Boards/Councils, a candidate shall have to pass in five recognized subjects, of which one shall be English, of full marks not being less than 100 each. A candidate passing in

four subjects shall not be eligible for admission.

- (iv) A candidate in UR Category taking up 4-YEAR UNDERGRADUATE Programme in a subject except Microbiology, must have to be qualified 10+2 examinations with 55% marks in aggregate and 45% marks in the subject or related subject at the previous qualifying examination.
- (v) Students with PWD category (GEN/OBC-A & OBC-B) who like to pursue any of the above mentioned Programmes except Microbiology (Honours)\* must have to be qualified their 10+2 examinations with 45% marks in aggregate and 40% marks in the subject or related subject at the previous qualifying examination except Microbiology (Honours.).
- (vi) Students belonging to the SC & ST Category seeking to pursue any of the Programmes except Microbiology (Honours.) must have to be qualified their 10+2 examinations with 50% marks in the aggregate and minimum 40% marks in the relevant subject at the 10+2 examinations in which they want to pursue UG Programme.
- (vii) For Microbiology (Honours),
  - a) A candidate should have passed the 10+2 examinations with a minimum 50% mark in aggregate in 10+2 science stream.
  - b) Students belonging to the SC & ST and differently able category should have passed the 10+2 examinations with a minimum 45% mark in aggregate in 10+2 science stream.

Note:

*The science stream includes subjects like physics, chemistry, biology, mathematics, astronomy, environmental sciences, computer science and developing fields like artificial intelligence and nanotechnology.*

**B) Reservation of Seats:** There will be reservation of seats for EWS/SC/ST/OBC/PWD candidates as per the norms issued by the Government of West Bengal time to time. For differently – able candidates minimum disability at least 40% will be considered.

#### **CALCULATION OF MERIT:**

a) For a Major course, where student has studied the subject at +2 level – Marks obtained in Major/related subject + Marks obtained in English + Best marks obtained in other three subjects excluding English & ENVS.

b) For a Major course, where student has not studied the subject at +2 levels – Marks obtained in English + Best marks obtained in other three subjects excluding English & ENVS.

The following formula will be used to calculate the merit score:

**Hons. Programme: (2S+T)/6**

S= HONS. SUBJECT

T= (English+ Best of 3)

Best of 3= Excluding English & ENVS

**B.B.A and Open programme(s) : T/4**

T = (ENGLISH + BEST of 3

Best of 3 = Excluding English& ENVS

**Note:** A candidate will be allowed to pursue a maximum of Three Year under one Major Course and one Minor Course if he/ she/ transgender have passed the qualifying Examination in Vocational Stream subjects.

**E. MERIT LIST:**

Admission process will be strictly online and on the basis of merit. Merit list will be prepared uniformly on the basis of the following criteria:

***Sample Calculation:***

**B.SC (MATHEMATICS HONS)**

SUBJECTS	OBTAINED MARKS	FULL MARKS
ENGLISH	83	100
BENGALI	86	100
CHEMISTRY	75	100
MATHEMATICS	98	100
PHYSICS	76	100
BIOLOGY	95	100

$$\text{EXAMPLE} = [(2 * 98) + (83+98+95+76)]/6 = 91.33$$

**RULES FOR SELECTION OF COURSES/ PAPERS:**

- I. The students of Arts department have to take minor courses from any one of the Arts courses (Except major courses).
- II. The students of Science department have to take minor courses from any one of the Science Subjects (Except major courses).

- III.** The students of Commerce, BBA and Computer & Information Science may take minor courses from any one of the BBA and Computer & Information Science subjects (Except major courses) and vice versa .
- IV.** Students are not allowed to take any courses as MDC which are already been selected by them as major and minor subjects.
